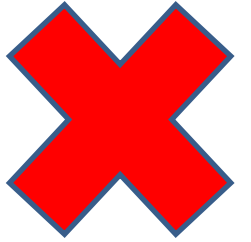

PROPER TECHNIQUE



Loosen your grip

Place elbow on table





Gently use the tip of brush



**Do not dip the whole
brush in paint**

Glide paint smoothly along paper to blend.

**Texture of paint mixed with a bit of
water is best like butter.**



**Do Not apply paint directly
on brush!**



**Paint should be
mixed in palette
before use !**

**Do Not drag paint
using side of brush**



**Do Not leave
brush with paint
to dry after use**



Paint should be
used appropriately,
not played with!

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**Do Not leave in brush water,
wash it up !**



**Wipe spilled water or
paint immediately!**
